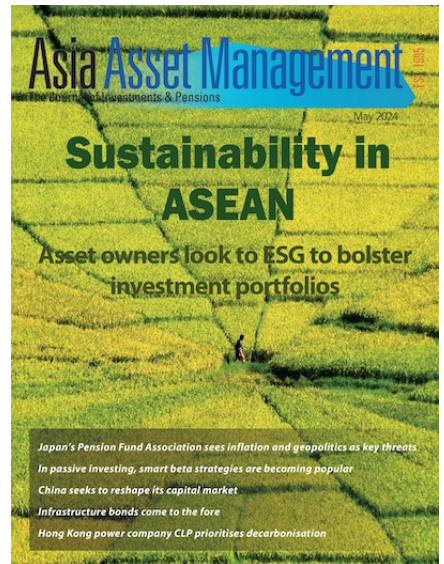


### Two decades of ESG
